We offer one of the best experiences in the world in a location renowned for its flowers and relaxed and safe lifestyle.


Namangan is a city in eastern Uzbekistan. It has been an important craft and trade center in the Fergana Valley since the 17th century. Famous for its “Flower’s Festival”, Namangan is named “Flowers City”.

The University campus is conveniently located just a few minutes away from the city centre. Easy connections to Andijan (1 hour), Fergana (2 hours) and Tashkent (4 hours).

There is a park named “Afsonalar Vodiysi” (Valley of Legends) which is the biggest attraction in Central Asia. The complex contains modern waterfalls, musical fountains and canals.

There are also huge shopping areas such as “Sardoba”, “Do’stlik” and “Chorsu”.



Access and Hours: Typically accessible to students and staff during the university's operating hours.


Library

Living in a TIU also means access to:

Four-bedroom rooms inside the campus are available for all exchange students. The room is equipped with a bed, desk, wardrobe, internet access and public laundry room.

Students will receive an email about room reservation after admission and need to reply to the email to reserve dormitory rooms on campus.

The monthly dormitory fee is only **25USD**. Students need to pay the accommodation fee once for one semester when check-in on registration dates at TIU.

Depending on the agreement between the partner universities, the dormitory can be free of charge.

Fees won't be returned back if students check-out during the semester. Exchange students are allowed to choose either to live on campus or find an apartment outside on your own.

Student Life Clubs and Competetions

Buddy Project



The Buddy project “Do you need support?” is a welcome- and support service for international students enrolled on a degree programme at TIU and for international exchange students.

A “Buddy” (a current student at TIU) will assist international students adapting to their new academic, cultural and linguistic environment before and on arrival in Turan International University.

What a Buddy does:

- They contact you first by email.
- They answer your most urgent questions (re: accommodation, academic organization, website of the University, administrative procedures on arrival, etc...).
- They assist you in finding the relevant administrative offices for your needs or help you find locations in the main university buildings (professors' offices, classrooms, canteens, libraries etc...).
- They assist you with online procedures.
- They can give you tips on life in Turan International University.



How to Apply



Step 1

Decide which faculty and which field you would like to pursue in Turan International University.

Step 2

Fill out the application form provided to your international office to start your application.

Step 3

Prepare all required documentation to your online application. This includes:

- a copy of the ID page of your passport (or other national ID),
- an up-to-date official academic transcript in English
- proof of English language proficiency. (optional)

Eligibility

- have completed at least one full-time semester of study at the partner university.
- be currently enrolled at an partner university.
- advised have a good command of English or Russian.

Arrival and Visas



Turan International University in Namangan runs an Airport Welcome service for exchange students depending on the agreement with a partner university. The transport will be organized to take you from your airport of arrival to your accommodation free of charge. Please note that the free airport welcome service is only available from Namangan International Airport prior to the student induction program.

Please ensure that you complete the online form by the relevant deadline date so that arrangements can be made for you. Once you have submitted your online form, you will receive an email to confirm that your space has been booked as well as further instructions.

Uzbekistan Visa

Visa-free nationalities

Citizens of Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Moldova, Russia, Kyrgyzstan, and Ukraine DO NOT NEED A VISA to enter the Republic of Uzbekistan.

- 30 days stay – Israel, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, South Korea, Tajikistan, and Turkey.

If you are not from one of the visa-free countries for Uzbekistan and you qualify for an electronic visa, you will have the easiest time applying. You can use the services rendered by **iVisa**. The entire process is online, and you only need a few things to help iVisa get started. You can find the information about visa requirements and costs there.

Where to apply for Uzbekistan Visa?

If you do not qualify for an Uzbekistan e-visa, your only option is the consular visa. You can also get a visa on arrival at the Tashkent International Airport, but even that entails a visit to Uzbekistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs. You need to get a visa confirmation. Other than that, if you are eligible for an electronic visa, you will see just how accessible it is. Not to mention that you can get your document in as little as 5 days.

You can apply for a visa where Uzbekistan Embassy or Consulate exists. Please note that the required documents and visa fees may differ based on your citizenship and where you apply.
